Contractual Items You Should Know...(www.sbta.org)

1. Final Evaluation Deadlines – Article XVI Section 9

"A written evaluation shall be presented to the unit member thirty (30) days prior to the last day of school. The unit member shall attend an evaluation conference prior to the last two (2) weeks of school. Two (2) school days prior to the evaluation conference, the unit member shall receive a copy of the evaluation."

****For B/C/D Tracks**, teachers being evaluated must have received their written evaluation on or before May 28, 2009.

2. Requesting a Different Evaluator – Article XVI Section 10

"Within ten (10) days of receipt of an evaluation that does not meet or exceed acceptable performance, the unit member may request another evaluator for the subsequent school year...If the District does not designate another evaluator, the unit member may file a request for voluntary transfer. The transfer request must be received by Human Resources prior to June 15 in order to be considered for the beginning of the next school year."
